The 5-day workshop is a part of the annual summer schools organized by the LabexMER.

The objective of this workshop is to learn, experience and gain the basic theoretical and practical skills required to process samples and identify taxa of the benthic meio- and macrofauna. A session will also be dedicated to deep-sea fauna associated with the nodule fields.

As a minimum requirement, candidates should hold a Bachelor of Science in marine environment, or 3 year technical degree in marine environment or equivalent. A first experience in taxonomy is desirable.

Ifremer will cover the following costs:

- International airfares (economy class, return ticket);
- Accommodation, local transports if required and meals for the duration of the workshop.

Submission of application should be in one of the official languages of the International Seabed Authority (ISA) in electronic format to training@isa.org.jm and should be received by 15 March 2016.

Application must be accompanied by:

- a) Application form to be completed by the applicant;
- b) Nomination form to be completed by the institution or governmental department.
