AD HOC COMMITTEE TO STUDY THE PEACEFUL

Note by the Secretary-General

Under operative paragraph 3 (c) of General Assembly resolution 2340 (XXII) of 18 December 1967, the Secretary-General was requested to render all appropriate assistance to the Ad Hoc Committee to study the peaceful uses of the sea-bed and the ocean floor beyond the limits of national jurisdiction, including the submission thereto, inter alia, of the results of the studies being undertaken in pursuance of General Assembly resolution 2172 (XXI).
