CORRIGENDUM

The following corrections have been requested by the delegations of Chile and Yugoslavia.

Page 2: The first paragraph should read as follows:

"Mr. PAVICEVIC (Yugoslavia) said that his delegation welcomed the Chairman's initiative in convening the Committee for a special series of meetings to consider the document in the light of its mandate and goals, before the text was discussed by the First Committee and it also appreciated the initiative taken by the Soviet Union and the United States in presenting the draft Treaty on the Prohibition of the Emplacement of Nuclear Weapons and Other Weapons of Mass Destruction on the Sea-Bed and the Ocean Floor and in the Subsoil Thereof. His delegation had already expressed its views on the draft Treaty at the Conference of the Committee on Disarmament and would elaborate on them in the First Committee."

The third paragraph should read as follows:

"As the Sea-Bed Committee could not examine the draft Treaty in detail during the short time now available to it, he hoped that the question would be discussed further, and in greater detail, by the

Sea-Bed Committee within the framework of its mandate and bearing in mind the debate on this question in the First Committee as well as its results."

Page 4: second line, before "military jurisdiction", add "actual"; fourth line, delete "quite".
