DECISION OF THE ASSEMBLY RELATING TO THE BUDGET OF THE INTERNATIONAL SEABED AUTHORITY FOR 1999

The Assembly of the International Seabed Authority

- 1. Adopts the revised budget of the Authority for 1999^1 in the sum of 5,011,700 United States dollars;
- 2. <u>Decides</u> that for 1999 the Secretary-General is authorized to transfer between appropriation sections up to 30 per cent of the amount in each section;
- 3. <u>Decides also</u> that, in view of the prevailing exceptional budgetary situation, there should be one three-week session of the Authority in 1999;
- 4. Recalls paragraph 2 of its resolution ISBA/3/A/9 concerning the Working Capital Fund, and decides that, should the funds in the Working Capital Fund prove inadequate to meet the shortfalls in cash flow, the Secretary-General is authorized to utilize, in 1999, available funds under his custody up to a limit of 20 per cent of the approved budget for 1999, provided that such borrowed sums shall be reimbursed as soon as contributions or advances are available;
- 5. <u>Decides</u> that advances and contributions shall be due and payable in full within 30 days of the receipt of the communication of the Secretary-General requesting payment, or as of 1 January 1999, whichever is later;
- 6. <u>Decides also</u> to request the Secretary-General to seek the appointment of a United Nations External Auditor to audit the Authority for 1998;

7. <u>Decides further</u> to request the Secretary-General to make a proposal regarding the appointment of an auditor for the consideration of the Finance Committee in 1999, including the appointment of government auditors, or a private audit firm, in each case on the most cost-effective basis.
