ON SITE COVID TESTING SERVICES

MDLink, a local medical service provider, will administer the Antigen and Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) tests at the Jamaica Conference Centre (Entrance Hall Lobby), from 8-10 December 2021 and 13-15 December 2021, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Cost and time frame for results

- Antigen test: 30-60 minutes / US\$70.00 or J\$10,000.00
- PCR test: 48 hours / US\$145.00 or J\$22,000.00
