With respect to those delegations which broke the silence only in respect of ISBA/26/C/L.4, please kindly find attached to this letter the letter dated 2nd December 2020 sent by the Permanent Representative of Brazil to the International Seabed Authority, on behalf of the members of the Latin American and Caribbean Group (GRULAC) who are members of the Council. The attached letter is being circulated upon request of the GRULAC.

It is my intention to convene a Bureau meeting to discuss next steps.
