 $\underline{\text{Noting}}$ that Canada and the United States of America ceased to be members of the $\overline{\text{International}}$ Seabed Authority on 16 November 1998,

 $\underline{\text{Noting further}}$ that, on 26 March 1998, Canada was elected as a member of Group C of the Council and the United States of America was elected as a member of Group A of the Council respectively, for a four-year period as from 1 January 1999,

<u>Elects</u> the following to fill the vacancies in the Council as from 1 January 1999, subject to the understandings reached in the regional and interest groups¹:
