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General Comments				
Australia confirms its position, as previously stated that these Guidelines can only be approved as part of a package, together with the Draft Exploitation Regulations ( <b>Regulations</b> ) and other Standards and Guidelines. We note also that to the extent these Guidelines refer to other Guidelines which are yet to be developed, it is appropriate to have a further opportunity to comment on this Guideline in the light of the other Guidelines once they have been prepared. The draft appears to build on obligations under the Regulations rather than clarifying the content of existing Regulations and how a Contractor can <i>demonstrate</i> compliance with the Regulations. To the extent that failure to include certain considerations or matters in the EMMP may give the LTC cause to reject an EMMP or require that it be amended, these would be obligations. As such, these matters should be contained in a Standard rather than a Guideline. These Guidelines should include a statement to the effect that where the Guidelines seemingly conflict with the Regulations, including its annexes, or any Standards, the Regulations or Standards will prevail. Australia reiterates comments made to the draft Regulations and Annex VII and considers that any proposed amendments to the Regulations should also be reflected in the Guidelines. While Section III seeks to provide additional guidance on completing an EMMP in accordance with Annex VII, not all of the requirements under Annex VII are addressed. Australia considers that Section III either requires clearer linking statements to relevant paragraphs in Annex VII or an overarching explanation that not all requirements in Annex VII are addressed in Section III. Support the document's focus on strong environmental regulation.
