REPLACE current proposed text with:

"... including plans for further <u>prevention</u>, <u>reduction</u>, <u>control and</u>, <u>where</u> appropriate, remediation ..."

The LOSC requires 'prevention, reduction and control,' in that order, as set out in, e.g., LOSC Article 145. The Closure Plan must cover at least all the required actions.

'Mitigation', as explained in detail in, e.g., ACOPS_
Proposal IWG ENV PartIV DR45c, must be removed from the draft regulations
entirely, unless the regulations are dealing with the circumstances set out in LOSC
Article 142, and replaced with the correct language.

Failure to address the above issues would be incompatible with the LOSC because the full scope of its environmental provisions would remain unimplemented as required and render the regulations vulnerable to legal challenge.
