Regarding para (2). In some jurisdictions, a private applicant cannot itself prepare an EIA given their potential conflict of interest and a contractor will need to adhere to the national law requirements for EIA of its sponsoring state. We therefore propose an amendment to account for differences in national law requirements.
