Belgium thinks that the Regulation would gain clarity and readability when it is structured in a different manner.

The first paragraph should refer to article 145 UNCLOS, as the guiding article for this Part IV 'Protection and preservation of the Marine Environment'.

The subsequent paragraphs should elaborate on the specific responsibilities per role (Authority, sponsoring State, Contractor etc.), even if this entails some repetition. A 'mutatis mutandis' description of these basic responsibilities is confusing and might create loopholes.
