On para 3 – this integration improves the readability of the Regulations and it is in accordance with most legal texts, where definitions stand in the beginning

On para 4 - we think we all agree that the freedom of scientific research, the right to conduct marine scientific research or the exercise by States of the freedom of the high seas shall not in any way be affected by these Regulations. This paragraph is correct, but also a bit confusing. Because there are other rights or freedoms that are also safeguarded by the Convention and are not mentioned in this paragraph. Therefore we propose a different wording, in order to combine the general principle that all rights and

freedoms in the Convention shall remain unaffected by these Regulations with the explicit mention of these three rights and freedoms in this para.
