Belgium also wants to thank the LTC for its work and the Chair and dr. Clark for their explanations during this session.

We want to join others by expressing our concerns about not knowing to what extent and why our comments have been taken into account (or not) after the first round of comments. That makes it very difficult to evaluate our position and adopt a new position, potentially discarding elements of the former position that have become superfluous or simply are not good enough. Consequently, we run the risk of turning in circles and not making progress.

One more general issue with respect to the content of the Standards & Guidelines: we understand that their focus is process-related. For instance, on the issue of environmental objectives or thresholds, we understand that it is difficult to produce them at this stage. And we even think they might be better embedded in the Regional Environment Management Plan. However, since we don't have a good view

yet on the REMPs in the Regulations, it is difficult for Belgium to rely on that alternative of having the environmental objectives in the REMPs. This illustrates once more the difficulty of working in parallel on the Regulations and the Standards and Guidelines.
