2. A Contractor shall notify the Secretary-General if it wishes to modify the Plan of Work. The Secretary-General shall, in consultation with the Contractor, consider whether a proposed modification to the Plan of Work constitutes a Material Change in accordance with the Guidelines Standards. If the Secretary-General considers that the proposed modification may constitutes a Material Change, the Secretary-General shall submit such matter to the Commission for consideration. If the Commission considers that the proposed modification constitutes a Material Change, the Contractor shall seek the prior approval of the Council based on the recommendation of the Commission under regulations 12 and 16, and before such Material Change is implemented by the Contractor.

4. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150 word limit]

This regulation implicates the issue whether modification of a Plan of Work by a Contractor constitutes a Material Change. Paragraph 2 provides that the Secretary-General shall consider whether a proposed modification to the Plan of Work constitutes a Material Change in accordance with the Guidelines, which is inappropriate. Two revisions are proposed. First, the "Guidelines" should be replaced by the binding "Standards". Second, the Secretary-General shall not consider whether a proposed modification constitutes a Material Change, it is suggested to be modified.
