1. At the end of an inspection, the Inspector shall prepare a <u>standardized</u> report, setting out, inter alia, his or her general findings and any recommendations for improvements in procedures or practices by the Contractor. The Inspector shall send the report to the <u>Compliance Committee</u>. <u>Secretary General, The Compliance Committee will present the report to the Council and the Secretary-General shall send. Aa copy of the report shall be send to the Contractor and to the sponsoring State or States and, if appropriate, the relevant coastal State or States and the flag State, and a copy shall be made public.</u>
