A Contractor shall take—all_all_necessary measures to protect and preserve and preserve the Marine Environment_from harmful effects, including by preventing, reducing and controlling pollution and other hazards, including marine litter and underwater noise including marine litter and underwater noise including marine litter and underwater noise from its activities in the Area, in accordance with the the-its Environmental Management and Monitoring Plan_and all applicable Rules of the Authority, the televant applicable Regional Environmental Management Plan, if any and the applicable Standards and taking account of the applicable Guidelines.

We support the amendments inserted by the Facilitator, if not indicated otherwise. In addition, we propose a few amendments, also in tracked changes. In line with other delegations, we do not see rationale of deleting the word "all" and request its reinsertion, in line with Art. 194 of the convention. Similarly, we suggest to reinsert "and preserve" and to delete "from harmful effects", in accordance with language contained in Part XII of the convention, also specifically in Article 194 where DR 49 relates to. As for the listed pressures we propose to keep the reference to noise and litter to add clarity, as the term "pollution" in many contexts do not traditionally include these issues. In general, it should be reconsidered to merge this DR with or at least link it to DR 48 on the EMMP.
