Health Requirements – COVID-19

At the time of writing of this document (3 November 2022), anyone can enter Korea regardless of their vaccination status. Pre-departure and after-entry COVID-19 tests are no longer required.

Travelers are still required to register their information into the Quarantine Information Pre-Entry System (Q-code) in advance of their flight to streamline the process upon arrival. Go to

<https://cov19ent.kdca.go.kr/>, select “Input”, and complete the subsequent steps. After completion, a QR-Code will be issued, which you will then present to the quarantine officer upon arrival in Korea.

Visa Requirements

Participants requiring an entry visa to the Republic of Korea are strongly advised to contact the nearest Korean diplomatic or consular mission **as soon as possible** to secure the required entry visa in a timely manner, prior to departure. It should be noted that airline companies will not allow boarding in the absence of a valid visa.

Please note that nationals of visa waiver countries or designated visa-free countries must obtain the Korean Electronic Travel Authorization (K-ETA) before entering the Republic of Korea. If that is your case, please proceed to apply for K-ETA here: <https://www.k-eta.go.kr/portal/apply/index.do>. The K-ETA process may take up to 72 hours and the result will be sent to your email address. Please have the printed copy ready for your trip. If you have a valid visa to enter Korea, you do not need K-ETA.

To facilitate the issuance of visas, the Secretariat will liaise with MABIK on the dissemination of visa support letters to be submitted with visa applications.

Electricity Supply

In the Republic of Korea, the power plugs and sockets are of type C and F. The standard voltage is 220v and the standard frequency is 60 Hz.

Weather

The average temperature in Seochon in November for a typical day, ranges from a high of 55°F (13°C) and a low of 42°F (5°C).

Transportation & Hotel

Overview

Participants should arrive at the Incheon International Airport in Seoul. Thereafter, a bus should be taken to Gunsan, where lodging is recommended (Please see Annex B). Details on the bus route and schedule are provided on page 5. There will be a complementary shuttle bus service daily, offering participants transportation between Gunsan City and Seochon for the meetings. The bus will be parked at the Avon Hotel, Gunsan City.

Air Travel: Incheon International Airport (ICN), Seoul

Incheon International Airport is the largest and main airport which serves the Seoul area.

The airport has two terminals. It is important that travellers are mindful of this.

- Terminal 1: 272, Gonghang-ro, Jung-gu, Incheon
- Terminal 2: 446, Je2terminal-daero, Jung-gu, Incheon

The Incheon Airport Information Centre, which is situated in Terminal 1, is located on the 1st floor (in front of Gate B or E).

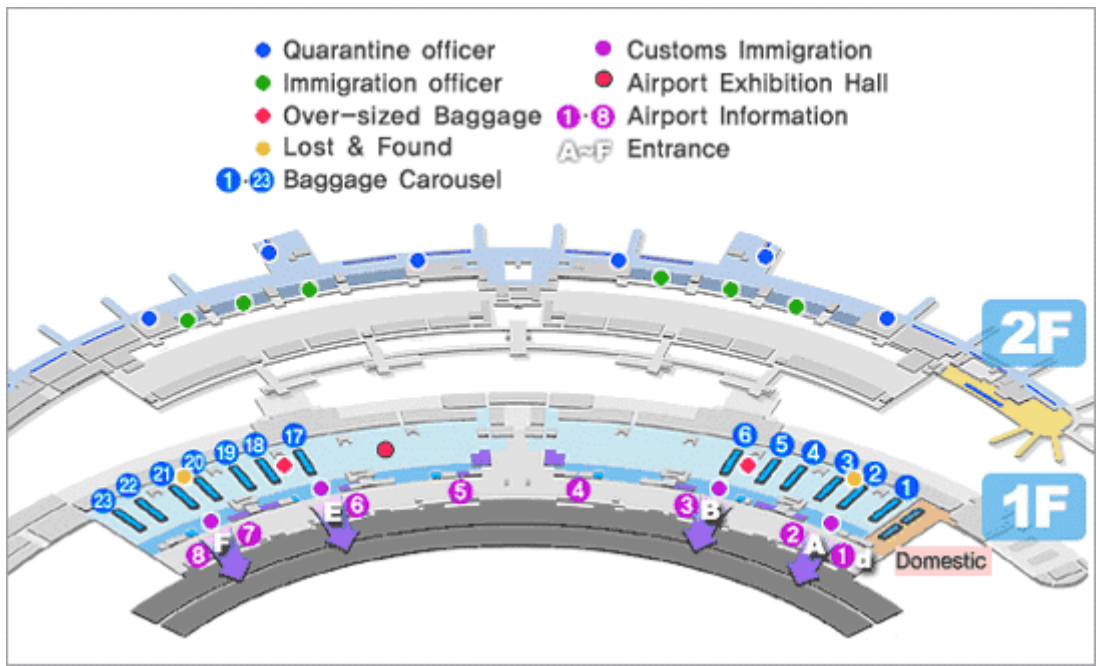

Airport Procedures

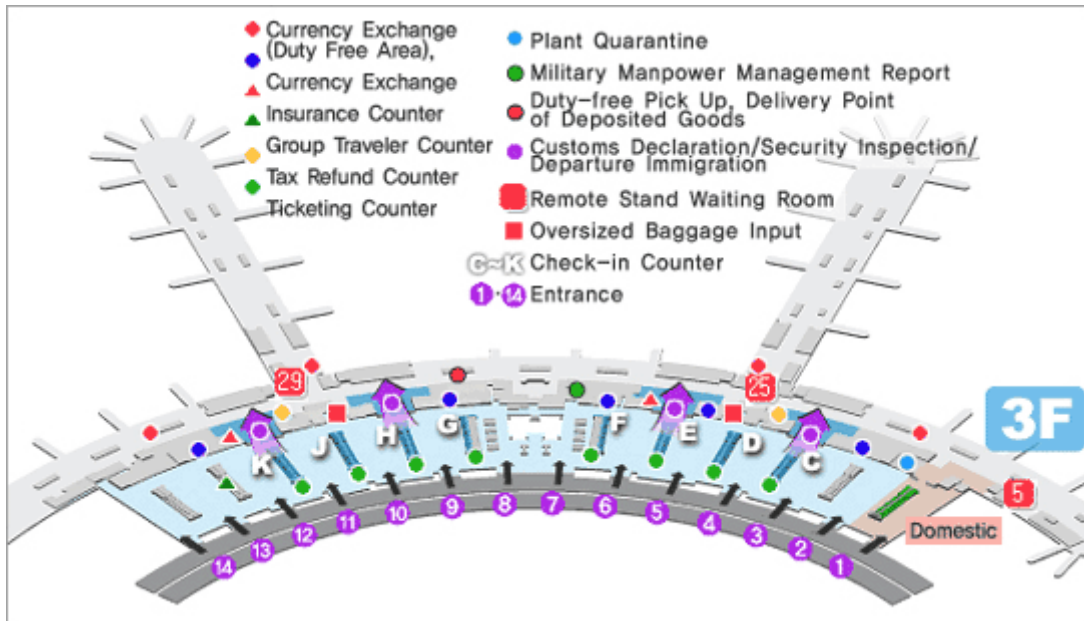
Arrival:

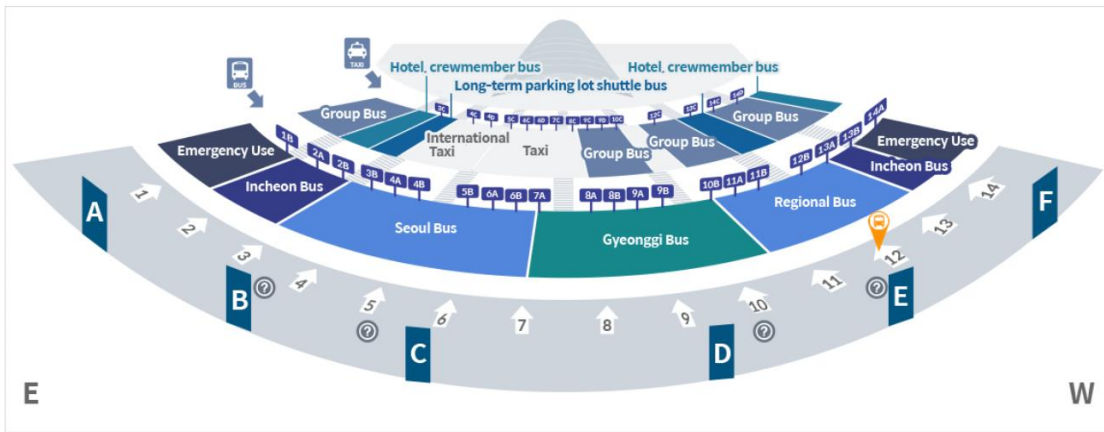

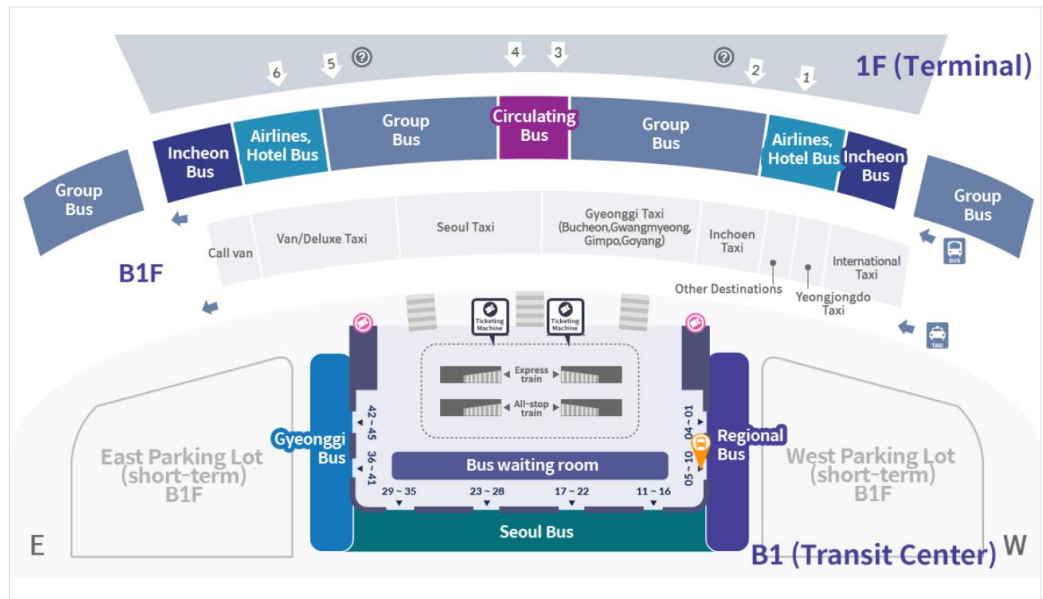

Terminal 2, Bus Stop Location (Transportation Centre Basement 1, No.9)

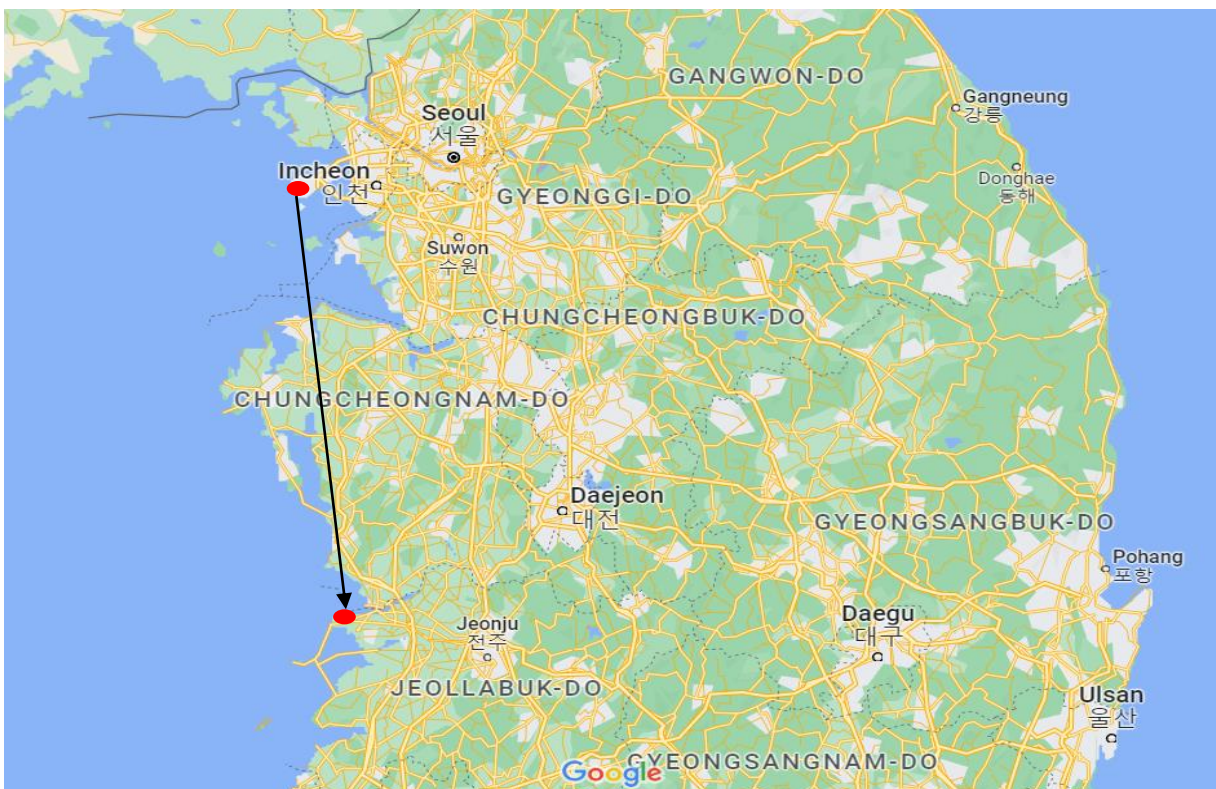


ANNEX A: EVENT VENUE & AREA MAP

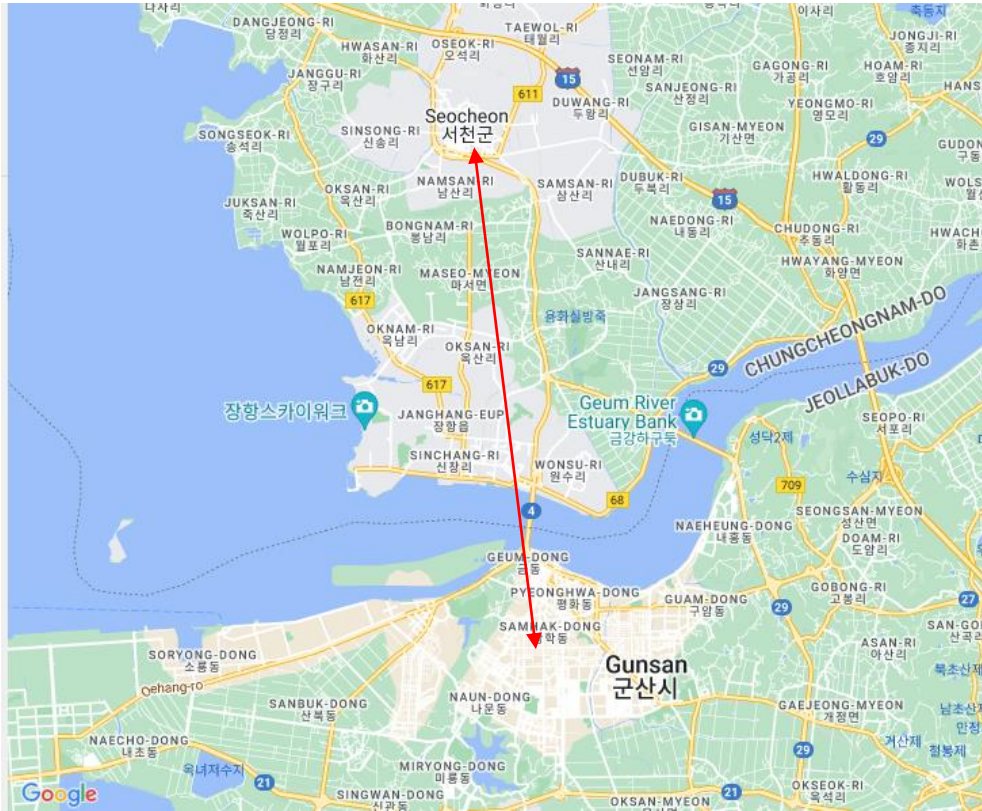

▪ Gunsan to Siachen-Gun



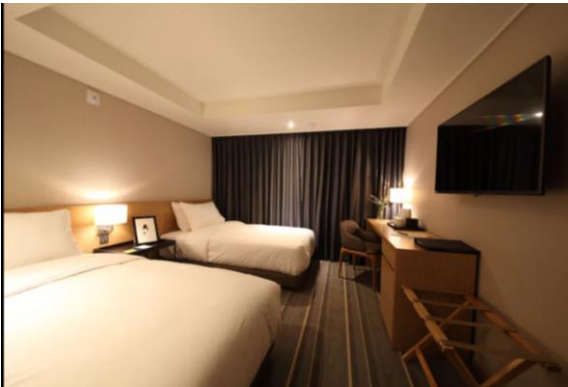
ANNEX B: HOTEL INFORMATION
