The Secretary-General shall give reasonable notice to the Contractor of the projected time and duration of inspections, the names of the Inspectors and any activities that the Inspectors are to perform that are likely to require the availability of special equipment or special assistance from the personnel of the Contractor, save in situations where the Secretary-General may without prior notification direct an inspection of the Contractor's activities in accordance with regulation 4(5) where the Secretary General has reasonable grounds to consider the matter to be so urgent that notice cannot be given, in which case the Secretary General may, where practicable, exercise the right to conduct an inspection without prior notification.
