The Authority, sponsoring States, the Enterprise and Contractors shall each, ~~as appropriate~~ within their respective competence and obligations, adopt, plan, implement and modify measures necessary for ensuring effective protection for the Marine Environment from harmful effects which may arise from Exploitation in the Area, including without limiting those from shipboard processing ~~immediately above a mine site of minerals derived from that mine site~~ and from transportation of minerals from the mine site to inland facilities, which may include inland processing, in accordance with the Convention, the Agreement, the rules, regulations and procedures adopted by the Authority ~~in respect of activities in the Area~~, as well as the Standards referred to in regulation 45. To this end, ~~they shall~~:

Activities in the Area shall be analyzed in a holistic and integral manner. ALL parties related to exploitation (Sponsor States, The Enterprise, Contractors, The Authority) shall take the necessary measures -according to the precautionary principle and within their respective competences and obligations- for ensuring effective protection of the Marine Environment from harmful effects, which may arise from ALL the exploitation-related activities.

These activities shall include the exploitation in the Area, as well as the shipboard processing (which not necessarily shall be performed “immediately above of the mining site”) and the transportation of the minerals from the exploitation area to inland disposal and inland processing, considering that all such activities entail risk of significant and harmful effects on the marine environment in both national and international jurisdiction and that Contractors shall be held liable for.
