The Fund [shall adhere to the polluter-pays principle and] will consist of, but not be limited to, the following monies:

- (a) The prescribed percentage or amount of fees paid [by Contractors] to the Authority;
- (b) The prescribed percentage of any penalties paid [by Contractors] to the Authority;
- (c) The prescribed percentage of any amounts recovered by the Authority by negotiation or as a result of legal proceedings in respect of a violation of the terms of an exploitation contract;
- (d) Any monies paid into the Fund at the direction of the Council, based on recommendations of the Finance Committee;
- (e) Any income received by the Fund from the investment of monies belonging to the fund;
- (f) An annual levy paid by Contractors to the Fund; and
- (g) The prescribed contributions paid by sponsoring States to the Fund.

## 4. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150 word limit]

The financing sources of the ECF shall consider the quotas of the sponsoring States and the possibility of contributions from other producing States.

According to the "polluter pays" principle, and considering that the ECF is of a residual nature, it is advisable that Contractors, in addition to the percentage established in the financial mechanism, pays an anual levy to the ECF<sup>1</sup>.
