The FSM supports the textual proposals above that were previously made by one or more members of the Council for paras (d) and (e) of draft exploitation regulation 3 in 2019, as captured in ISBA/26/C/CRP.1. For para (d), consultation and cooperation pertain to, among other things, the protection of the Marine Environment (in sub-para (i)), and it is critical to involve coastal States whose maritime zones are ecologically connected to or otherwise adjacent to the location of Exploitation activities in the Area. Similarly, for para (e), the observation, measurement, evaluation, and analyze of impacts of Exploitation activities in the Area will be incomplete without the active involvement of the above-mentioned relevant adjacent coastal States.
