It shall keep under surveillance the effects of the mining operation to determine whether it is likely to have harmful effects on the marine environment

2 The A Contractor shall cooperate with the Authority and the sponsoring State or States in the establishment and implementation of environmental monitoring programmes

3and shall submit data and information, in accordance with the <u>relevant applicable</u> Standards, and taking into account the <u>relevant applicable</u> Guidelines...

- 1 Drafting style and consistency.
- 2 This paragraph can be simplified, with a more general application beyond pollution. While "recognized scientific methods" is used in the Convention (article 165(2)(h)), the concepts adopted in the draft regulations are preferable.
- 3 Consistency in use of terminology.
- A Needs to be consistency across the regulations. For example, regulation 46bis uses "applicable" not relevant. Suggest that "applicable" is used across the entirety of the regulations, including "applicable Regional Environmental Management Plan".
