Norway fully supports an obligation to carry out an environmental impact assessment. Norway supports the reference to cumulative effects in DR 46 bis (2) b). This is important and must also be reflected in the EIS. The relationship between EIA and EIS is unclear and must be further clarified and streamlined. Norway supports a clear demand for public stakeholder consultations. It is not clear in the DR when and on the basis of what documents such consultations are to be held. Norway supports stakeholder consultations at the "scoping stage" based on a scoping report (as set out in the EIA standard) and before the EIA/draft EIS (as applicable) is finalized and submitted to the Authority.
