2alt The Authority shall facilitate the exchange of knowledge, information and experience relating to Incidents between Contractors, and with States, and shall draw on the advice of other relevant international organizations, so that such knowledge and information can be used by:

- a. Contractors to meet the requirements of regulation 53(1), and
- b. The Authority to prepare and revise relevant Standards and Guidelines.

Regarding paragraph 2, we believe it would be helpful to make the delineation of roles and responsibilities of Contractors and Authority clearer, whereby 1) the ISA is responsible for facilitating the exchange of information, ii) Contractors must conform to requirements, and iii) the ISA must prepare and revise regulatory instruments based upon the knowledge acquired from the Incident. We recommend that paragraph 2 be substituted with 2alt.
