We prefer the term "impact" instead of "effect". [3 (b)] Removal of "if any". [3 (c)] New wording including "consistent with other plans in these regulations" as stated in (d). [3bis (b)] In order to provide a clear meaning of the sentence it should be included: "how it will be set out". [3ter] An alternative wording is suggested. In line with the German comments, Spain considers that there must be a continuous monitoring of the operation, and thus the regulation should not limit the monitoring to a seven-year period. 4. An alternative wording is suggested. We consider that the monthly basis is not always the most suitable one, depending on the particular project.
