1.bis The Council shall approve and maintain a code of conduct for Inspectors and inspections, that takes into account the principles in paragraph (1) and includes provisions on identifying and managing conflicts of interest, and on information management and confidentiality.

2. The Contractor shall permit the Authority to send its Inspectors, who [may][shall upon request by sponsoring States or other party be concerned] be accompanied by a representative of the its sponsoring State or other party concerned, in accordance with article 165 (3) of the Convention, aboard all vessels and Installations whether offshore or onshore, used by the Contractor to carry out Exploitation activities under an exploitation contract as well as to enter its offices wherever situated. To that end, Members of the Authority, in particular the sponsoring State or States, shall assist the Council, the Secretary-General and Inspectors in discharging their functions under the Rules of the Authority.

6. Inspectors shall:

(a) Follow [all reasonable] instructions and directions pertaining to the safety of life at sea given to them by the Contractor and, the captain master of the vessel or other relevant safety officers aboard vessels and Installations; and

(b) [To the maximum extent possible,] Refrain from any undue interference with the [safe and] normal operations of the Contractor and of vessels and Installations, unless

the Inspector has reasonable grounds for believing that the Contractor isoperating in breach of its obligations under an exploitation contract.

- Para 1 (bis) The UK welcomes addition of a code of conduct for Inspectors and inspections.
- Para 2 The UK can support "shall". The reference to Article 165(3) here is inappropriate as that Article relates to the LTC undertaking inspections not an inspectorate so the cross-reference confuses the issue.
- Para 6 (a) The UK considers that reference to a "captain" should be a "master".
- Para 6 (b), The UK can accept the first deletion. The UK considers that "safe" should remain as there could be a safety issue outside of the normal operations of the vessel.
