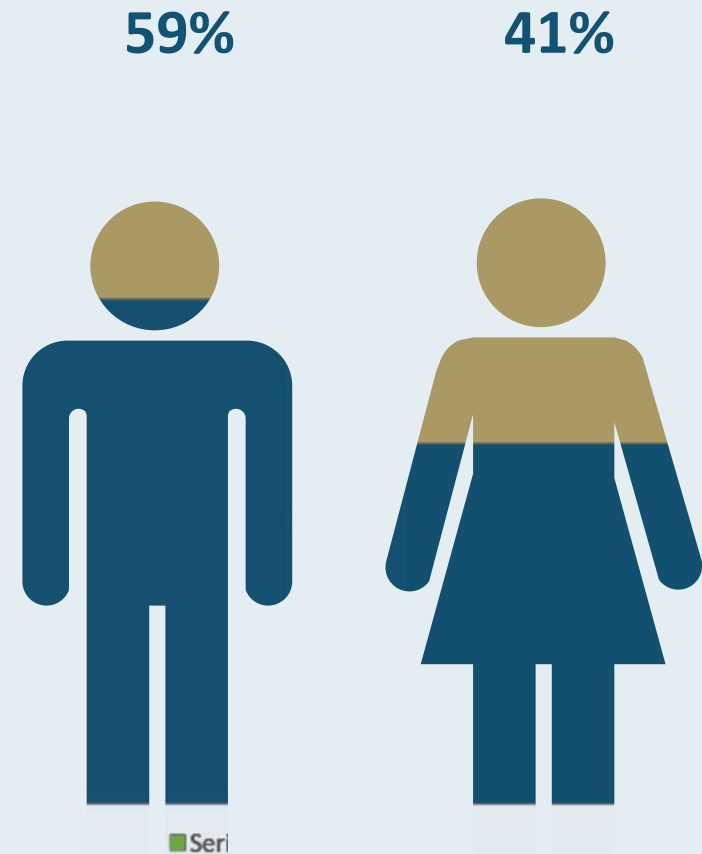

OVERALL GENDER REPRESENTATION

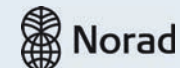

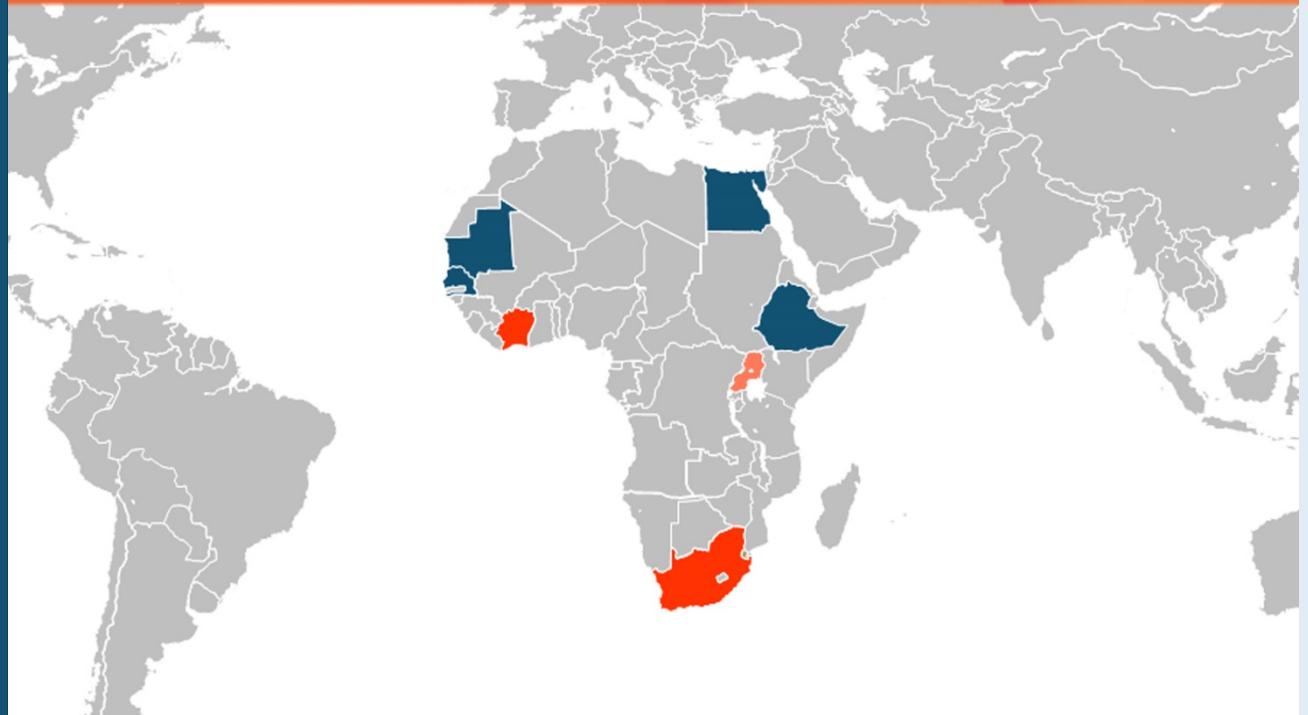
