Regarding paragraph 3, according to Article 20, Annex III, of the Convention, rights and obligations arising from a contract are only transferable with the consent of the Authority and such transfer shall be in accordance with rules, regulations and procedures of the Authority. According to the delegation of functions of the Authority, the Council is mandated to approve the transfer. It shall, based on the recommendation

of the Commission, consider the information submitted by the proposed transferee in accordance with paragraphs 11 and 12 of Section 3 of the Annex to the 1994 Implementing Agreement.

Regarding paragraph 4, in accordance with Article 166, paragraph 3, the Secretary-General shall perform administrative functions. Whether there are material changes in the plan of work is not an administrative matter, which is beyond the mandate of the Secretary-General. Pursuant to Article 153, paragraph 3, and Article 165 paragraph 2(b), the plan of work shall be reviewed by the Commission, based on whose recommendation the Council makes a decision.
