Regarding paragraph 1, the sponsoring State and the Authority are the regulatory authorities of the activities in the Area, and the Contractor shall, as soon as reasonably practicable, notify its relevant situation to both of them. Where the Secretary General receives such a notification and considers it genuinely relevant to the coastal State, the Secretary-General may, at his/her discretion, notify the coastal State.

Regarding paragraph 3, this paragraph is to notify the regulatory authorities, to which coastal States obviously do not pertain.
