The Report of the Chair of the Legal and Technical Commission on the work of the Commission at the second part of its twenty-fifth session (Addendum, ISBA/25/C/19/Add.1) has provided that standards and guidelines should be in place in stages, i.e. Stage 1 are those that need to be in place prior to the adoption of the Draft Exploitation Regulations, Stage 2 are those that need to be in place prior to the receipt of applications for plans of work for exploitation, and Stage 3 are those that need to be in place prior to the commencement of commercial mining activities in the Area. This paragraph is ambiguous and is suggested to be deleted.
