At least 12 months prior to the proposed commencement of production in a Mining Area or at the time of submitting an application for a Plan of Work, the Contractor shall provide to the [Secretary-General] [Commission] a Feasibility Study prepared in accordance with Good Industry Practice, taking into account the Guidelines fas well as the results of the test mining study pursuant to Regulation [48bis], paragraph 2 or 3, as applicable, and in accordance with Annex fIV ter-1. In the light of the Feasibility Study fand the test mining study, fthe Secretary General shall consider whether any Material Change needs to be made to the Plan of Work in accordance with regulation 57 (2). If he or she determines that any such Material Change needs to be made, the Contractor shall prepare and submit to the Secretary General a revised Plan of Work accordingly] the Secretary-General shall consider whether any Material Change needs to be made to the Plan of Work in accordance with regulation 57 (2). If he or she determines that any such Material Change needs to be made, the Contractor shall prepare and submit to the Secretary-General a revised Plan of Work accordingly flf the Secretary General considers any Material Change needs to be made to the Plan of Work, he or she shall submit this matter to the Commission. ## 5. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

 We oppose the proposed amendments to Draft Regulation 25(1), with the exception of the additional text concerning test mining, as the proposed amendments are inconsistent with other key provisions of the Draft Regulations concerning the assessment of a Plan of Work and the determination of a Material Change.

- We support the previous text, which we have modified as a result of the inclusion of a requirement for test mining and the preparation of a test mining study.
- Pursuant to Draft Regulation 57(2), it is the Secretary-General that determines
  whether a modification to a Plan of Work constitutes a Material Change. We
  consider that a consistent approach should be adopted in Draft Regulation 25(1),
  and that the Secretary-General should also make such a determination. This
  consistent approach will limit divergences in practice and provide for a more
  streamlined administration of the Regulations.
- We have also proposed a slight addition to the existing text to make it clear that a Feasibility Study may also be submitted at the time of submitting an application for a Plan of Work.
