"Good Industry Practice" ["Best Industry Practice"] means the exercise of that degree of skill, diligence, prudence and foresight which would reasonably and ordinarily be expected to be applied by a skilled and experienced person engaged in the marine mining industry and other related extractive industries worldwide, [based on Best Environmental Practice, which is based on Best Available Scientific Information and Best Available Technology]. [Employment of the latest widely accepted stage of development (state of the art) of processes, of facilities or of methods of operation, consistent with the Fundamental Principles, including using skill, diligence, prudence and foresight which is an would reasonably be expected to be applied by a skilled and experienced person engaged in the marine mining industry]

"Material Change" means a significant change that affects to the fundamental basis on which the an original report, document or plan, including a Plan of Work, was accepted or approved by the Authority, and includes changes such as physical modifications, [changes to harmful effects of activities on the Marine Environment, environmental effects or effects on stakeholders] the availability of new knowledge or technology and changes to operational management that are to be considered in the light of the applicable Guidelines.

Good industry practice: we have a preference for the original text. GIP is a generally accepted term in a land-based context as well as a key concept and benchmark in the regulations (see ISBA/25/C/11). While the Commission did not consider it appropriate to develop guidelines for GIP, we feel this should be revisited in due course.

Material change: in order to operationalise this term, a "threshold" (for example, "significant") needs to be incorporated into the language.
