Public complaints and whistle-blowing procedures

- **1.** The Council shall develop and implement:
 - (a) A whistle-blowing policy for the staff of the Authority, the Inspectorate, and the Enterprise according to international principles of transparency and accountability, and
 - (b) A public complaints procedure to facilitate reporting to the Authority by any person of any concerns about the activities in the Area.

The aim of the new regulation in Part XI of the Exploitation Regulations is twofold: (a) to reinforce transparency and accountability in the administration of the resources of the Area by the Authority on behalf of mankind and to avoid internal misconduct and fraud. One of the most effective methods for preventing misconduct and detecting corruption within an organization is the establishment of safe and reliable whistleblower channels. Legal basis: article 137 (2), article 153 (1), (4), article 157 (1), article 167 (2). (b) To ensure public participation procedures according to the draft regulation 3 (c). Public in general should have the right to report damage to the marine environment of the Area in application of the common heritage of mankind principle. Legal basis: article 136, article 137 (2), article 145
