 - (s) Details of reporting requirements and timing, including details of the methodology to be applied to ensure that monitoring data submitted are provided in an accessible and interpretable format consistent with best scientific practices.

- In paragraph (o), limiting this to discharges as defined under IMO conventions may not capture all discharges of relevance to the ISA. E.g., Article 145 provides that "drilling, dredging, excavation, disposal of waste, construction and operation or maintenance of installations, pipelines and other devices related to such activities" are "activities in the Area," and therefore under the remit of the ISA (see also ISA Technical Study No. 25, which states "Article 145 of UNCLOS, expressly and exclusively empowers ISA to regulate for the prevention, reduction and control of pollution and other hazards to the marine environment from activities in the Area.")
- In paragraph (s), we recommend that details on data submission formatting be added for consistency with the suggested proposal for DR 44 on applying best scientific practices to environmental data and information submissions from mine sites.
