The Contractor shall [immediately] notify the Secretary General in writing within 24 hours of any Upon finding in the Contract Area of any human remains or any object or site of an archaeological or historical, cultural, [and paleontological] nature, or any object or site of a similar nature, the Contractor shall:
 - (a) take best available measures to preserve the object and site; and
 - (b) within 24 hours notify the Secretary-General in writing providing details of the find, and its location, including the preservation and protection measures taken.
- 2. The Secretary-General shall transmit such information received pursuant to paragraph 1, [within 7 Days of receiving it] to the Ssponsoring State, to the State from which the remains, [object or site] originated, if known, to the Director General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization and to any other competent international organization.
- 3. Following the finding of any such human remains, object or site in the Contract Area, and in order to avoid disturbing such human remains, object or site, the Contractor shall undertake no further Exploration or Exploitation shall take place, within a reasonable radius, [to be determined by the Authority] until such time as the Council decides otherwise, after taking into account the views of the State from which the remains originated, the Director General of the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization or any other competent international organization.

These proposed amendments, including breaking up DR35 into separate numbered paragraphs, are largely to clarify drafting, and also to include a specific duty to preserve the object / site (in keeping with Article 149 of UNCLOS). We also believe it is appropriate and relevant to include 'cultural' items and sites in this Regulation.
