Reasonable regard for other activities in the Marine Environment

There are a number of terms that need better definition. These terms should be defined with input from the whole spectrum of ISA stakeholders.

There are also a few terms that have been defined (see Schedule, Use of terms and scope, of the President's Text) for which we see room for improvement.

• We strongly recommend the deletion of 31(1)(alt)(ter). We are concerned that DR 31(1)(alt)(ter) seeks to expand the definition of "Activities" as used in the Convention. The term "other activities in the marine environment" is used in both Article 147(1) and Article 147(3) of the Convention. We consider that the kinds of "other activities in the marine environment" contemplated by Articles 147(1) and 147(3) are activities undertaken by humankind operating in the marine environment, not activities of the marine environment itself. We consider that "climate mitigation carried out by ecosystem in the Area, such as carbon burial and sequestration and nutrients recycling" cannot be considered "other activities in the marine environment" as these are potential functions of the marine environment. Any expected impacts and effects to functions of the marine environment should be dealt with in the Environmental Impact Statement and Environmental
