- There is text in DR46(ter)(3) that duplicates Regulation 48.3bis.
- We are not sure why the monitoring would be potentially limited to the first seven years of
 exploitation. We imagine some form of monitoring would be required throughout the duration of
 exploitation, although it would likely be more intensive at the start of operations and become less
 intensive as time goes on.
- Monitoring by independent experts raises several questions about practicability (e.g., expert
 qualifications [who 'certifies' and who decides who is an expert?]; duplication of activities on site,
 who funds?, operational safety [would there be a separate monitoring vessel on site?], what happens
 if the work of the independent experts is disrupted, etc?)
- We suggest that the monitoring should be conducted by the Contractor as per the EMMP but independently verified by the ISA. The ISA could reach out to independent experts for assistance if they (the ISA) deem it necessary.
