[paragraph 2] Italy suggests to keep the term “discharge” as highlighted above.

[paragraph 4] Italy also suggests keeping a register of discharges to be updated at least weekly, allowing to it be consulted in real time. This would enhance transparency and allow evaluating possible impacts of discharges.
