The Federated States of Micronesia proposes tweaking paragraph 2 of DR 94 to clarify that Standards are developed on the basis of not just Best Available Scientific Evidence, but also on the bases of Best Environmental Practices, Best Available Techniques, and Good Industry Practice, all of which are referenced in connection with various elements of the DRs that will likely be complemented by such Standards (particularly DRs pertaining to the environment).
