The Secretariat shall arrange for the effective management of the submitted information in order to overcome existing gaps in knowledge concerning the marine ecosystems including their sensitivity and resoloence, the determination of environmental quality standards and appropriate exploitation equipment.

- We support the original wording of Draft Reg. 38(2)(b).
- The revised wording is unclear regarding its intended scope (e.g., whether "extracted" and "produced" Resources, Minerals and metals includes material lifted from and redeposited on the seafloor).
- We separately consider that Draft Reg. 38(2)bis is out of place in the current section, which otherwise deals exclusively with a Contractor's annual report.
- We suggest removing this provision and placing it elsewhere in the regulations.
