1. A royalty return shall include the following information for each royalty return period, in accordance with the Standard and taking into account the Guidelines:

(a) The quantity in wet metric tons dry metric tons of mineralmetal-bearing ore recovered from each Mining Area;

(b) The quantity and value by <u>Mineral metal</u> in <u>wet metric tons</u> dry metric tons of the <u>mineral metal</u>-bearing ore shipped from the Mining Area; The value and the basis of the valuation (by <u>Mineral Metal</u>) of the <u>mineral metal</u>- bearing ore sold or removed without sale from the Mining Area, as verified by a <u>suitably qualified person Suitably</u> Qualified Person and supported by a representative chemical analysis of the ore by a certified laboratory;

2. In respect of a final royalty return period ending on the date of expiry, surrender or termination of the exploitation contract, the Contractor shall provide:

(c) The quantity and value (by <u>Mineral Metal</u>) of all closing stocks of the <u>mineral metal</u>bearing ore.

- We are content with measurements in dry metric tons
- We consider there will need to be an agreed procedure for how weights, which will be on a wet basis, will be converted to a dry basis. We consider this should be specified in the applicable Standard and/or Guideline on the payment of royalties.

• References to 'by Mineral' should be 'by metal' because the mineralogy of nodules is fluid depending upon the level of desiccation and moisture content.
