As noted by Australia, African Group, United Kingdom, Russia, and Norway, we suggest that subparas (1)(f) &(g) and paras 3 & 4 are retained. Original documents or samples may be required for evidentiary purposes in national proceedings. In addition, samples may need to be seized for additional testing, such as checking metal content that is claimed for royalty purposes or to test environmental samples.
