TRAVEL GUIDELINES TO JAMAICA

As of September 1, 2023, all travellers entering Jamaica are required to complete the Immigration and Customs Declaration [C5] form online, prior to travel. The form is accessible at

www.enterjamaica.com. This is the official and only authorised site to be used for the submission of the declaration forms.

Delegates are advised to check the airline regarding requirements for the outgoing trip. In case COVID testing is required during your stay in Kingston, please contact Lilian Valles at <u>lvalles@isa.org.jm</u>.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Daily transportation service, properly identified, will be available to delegates at a cost of 10 USD/1,500 JAD for round trip and 5 USD/800 JAD for a one-way trip. Buses will leave from the Pegasus Hotel in the morning, accessible to nearby properties (Courtleigh Hotel, Liguanea Club, Marriot Courtyard Hotel) and depart from the Jamaica Conference Centre at the end of the afternoon session.

Delegates staying at the R Hotel, Spanish Court Hotel and the AC Hotel who are interested in getting advantage of this service are invited to send an email, at least five (5) days before arrival, to Lilian Valles at <u>lvalles@isa.org.jm</u> to coordinate with the service provider.
