When considering a Plan of Work, it is important that the LTC and Council are able to assess the applicant's financial situation and their ability to deliver the financial cost of the Plan of Work. This will require reference to the financial requirements for the plan, including requirements under the Environmental Compensation Fund.

On that basis, Australia considers it very important that the requirements for the Fund are in place prior to approval of the first Plan of Work for exploitation. We strongly support reverting to the original text.
