1. A Contractor shall pay the royalty due for a royalty return period on the Day the royalty return is required to be lodged. [The Council may request the advance payment of any royalty due by way of instalment where special circumstances exist, in accordance with relevant Standards and [Guidelines] [rules, regulations and procedures of the Authority], to reflect for instance impacts on ecosystem services and the natural capital.]

5. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

- 1. Currently, royalties are paid every six months, which is a short cycle. If an advance payment is required, it will undoubtedly put unreasonable management and financial pressure on the contractor.
- 2. The reason for the advance payment is to reflect the impact on ecosystem services and natural capital in special circumstances. What are special circumstances? If there is a significant impact on the environment, mining activities need to be stopped immediately rather than making an advance payment; if the economic valuation of ecosystem services and natural

capital has been clarified, payment can be made according to the normal process without an advance payment.
