2.(f) [Minimum] [t]echnical [and operational] requirements for environment protection with regard to [all] the equipment used for the Exploitation activities.

## 5. Please indicate the rationale for the proposal. [150-word limit]

Para 2(f): The Authority should <u>not</u> specify equipment requirements in a standard. This is overly prescriptive and counter to a results or outcomes-based approach to environmental regulation which supports innovation in technology advancement by contractors. Given the requirement to apply best available techniques, it would be preferable to set out any guiding parameters or recommendations in say a BAT guideline as regards technology and techniques.

Para 3: There is the potential for undue delays in the development and adoption of such standards. We propose language similar to that proposed at regulation 46bis(2) to cater for this.

Para 5: it is the function of the Commission to develop standard and guideline documentation, albeit at the discretion of the Council to determine that a standard is required.
