Paras 1 and 1ter: changes consistent with other regulatory provisions.

Paras 2 and 6: consistent with our comments on regulation 52, paragraph 4, we see it as challenging to link the Commission's consideration and approval of matters or documents to its twice-yearly meetings. The Commission is empowered to work intersessionally, and should examine the Closure Plan, revisions to the Closure Plan or any representations made to that effect, within 90 days of receipt to ensure there is no unnecessary regulatory delay.
