- (a) Carry out inspections in accordance with internationally accepted principles of good seamanship so as to avoid risks to the safety of life at sea, and where appropriate follow instructions and directions pertaining to the safety of life at sea given to them by the Contractor and the master of the ship vessel.
- 2. The Compliance Committee, upon the notification of any Member State on reasonable grounds that an inspection is expedient to prevent Contractor non-compliance or harm to the Marine Environment, shall promptly initiate inspection.
