On para 4, we support the sub-paragraph, but wonder if the word 'relevant' could be deleted here as unnecessary.

We appreciate the drafting clarity provided in para 5 alt, but would like to retain the obligation to provide an overview of other legitimate activities in the area under application from original para 5, in addition to whether or not the area is managed under another international regime or organisation. Perhaps (5) and (5) alt could be merged as suggested above.
