In the event of Harm to the Marine Environment and the livelihood of any coastal community, adjacent <u>A</u> coastal States which hasve grounds for believing <u>that such</u> <u>Serious</u>harm <u>to the Marine Environment in areas under its jurisdiction</u> is caused by activities in the Area, shall notify the Secretary-General in writing through appropriate channels of the grounds upon which such belief is based and request an inspection. <u>Such information shall be promptly circulated among the Members of the Authority</u>.

2. The Secretary-General, upon the notification of <u>the respective a</u> Member State, shall promptly <u>request the Compliance Committee to</u> initiate inspection, and invite representatives of coastal States <u>affected</u> to participate in the inspection, no later than 24 hours after such notification was made by the States, to <u>facilitate</u> assess<u>ment by the</u> Councilwhether <u>pollution</u> the Serious harm is attributable to activities in the Area.
